

Mite Eradication with Wondercide™: 3 Steps MUST be done

The 2 most common mites are Bird (small, red or black, visible) & Columbella (transparent, not visible)

Number one: The environment must be fogged to kill the excess population of mites propagated by the phenomenon. This treatment should encompass the outside areas as well as the inside of the structure. Use BioDefense™ with the TRI-JET Fogger machine inside and EcoTreat™ with hose end sprayer outside. While we offer the fogger for rent, it is STRONGLY recommended that you purchase the fogger. It will be used for repeat applications as mites are very difficult to eliminate. Indoor treatments may range from a couple of applications to fogging once a week for months (in severe cases). Rest assured BioDefense™ is non toxic so you can safely remedy the problem with the only proven effective product on the market today. One treatment will likely not solve the problem but a strict protocol will.

Number two: You must kill the mites that are in the epidermal layer of your skin. This is done by treating your body with Biter Fighter™ or BioDefense™ solution. You will have to treat the affected skin areas twice daily. Your body will reject the solution after 12 hours. This should give you considerable relief as the solution will penetrate the epidermal layer of the skin delivering the cedar oil active to the parasite and subsequently killing it.

Number three: If the mite infestation is allowed to get established in yourself, the animals and the structure, it is entirely possible the use of an internal parasite medicine such as [Stromectol](#) will be necessary to rid yourself of the pest. Mite infestations of pets, structures and subsequently a human host have increased dramatically in the last few years. What was once viewed as a phenomenon now appears to be an everyday occurrence. The application of PET MEDS or commonly known Flea or Spot Drops to the neck of your pet often result in a internal skin parasite issue in your pet and yourself. Fiprinol and other toxins wicked systemically into the animals blood stream result in the creation of a compromised immune system prohibiting the pets' body from resisting attack from these wicked internal parasites. Once identified as a host, the mites will attack the dog or cat with overwhelming vigor. Additional mite populations are propagated and in a short period of time the animal and the structure is the recipient of a full blown mite infestation.

When the pets immune system is compromised with the PET MEDS, its filtering organs cease to function properly and subsequently the blood carried mite will migrate into the epidermal layer of the skin through the blood stream capillaries. When the animal can no longer support the mite population it is hosting, the parasite will adopt another host within the structure. This is normally the care giver or the closest person to the animal. Often this is a chemically imbalanced or less healthy individual that may itself have an over-reactive or compromised immune system. Once infested with the parasite a persons' normal life style is totally disrupted. Constant biting and itching sensations and subsequent eruptions of the skin become debilitating and difficult to endure. The mites will attack the individual from the inside and the outside. Visual contact is next to impossible and medical diagnosis from the majority of the medical community is that of parasitic psychosis.

Treatment requires fogging or fumigation of the structure with applications of BioDefense™, a low molecular weight silicone fluid carrier and modified essential oil of the juniperus virginiana tree (cedar)

to the human and animal's body. Internal relief can be obtained with properly dosed regimens of Stromectol, a prescription drug used for eradication of internal parasites. Reduction of the mite population within the structure and surrounding areas and on the human and animals body surface is the first step in elimination of this horrible dilemma. Once this is accomplished and the intake of the parasite is minimized, the mammals' body will resume its normal eradication of the COLUMBELLA mite. PET MEDS should be immediately discontinued from any animal health protocols practiced. Immune system elevating foods and vitamins should be utilized.
